Fermilab Artist-in-Residence Program for 2018

Fermilab is America's national laboratory dedicated to particle physics research. To initiate and stimulate communication and interactions among scientists, artists and the public, the laboratory has created an Artist-in-Residence program and seeks applications for the 2018 cycle.

The Fermilab artist in residence will interact with scientists at the laboratory, learn about their research, see how it connects to society, and then use this information to create a body of work, ideally leading to presentations in the local community and an exhibition of the artwork at Fermilab and other places. A small stipend will be provided by the Fermi Research Alliance.

Applying to the Artist-in-Residence Program

Applications and questions for the 2018 Artist-in-Residence program should be submitted to art@fnal.gov

The application period opens June 10, 2017, closes September 10, 2017. Artists might be contacted for an interview and a presentation of examples of their portfolio.

Artists will be notified before November 20, 2017.

For your submission: The subject line of your email should read: Last Name, First Name AIR2018, 1 of 1 (if sending 1 email) 1of 2 (if sending 2 emails) etc.

No ZIP files, Accepted formats for attachments are .doc, .docx, .pdf, .jpg

Please submit:

- Resume/CV
- Artist statement
- Letter of intent, describing what you hope to accomplish through this residency and how you would contribute to the program and the community.
- 1 letter of reference
- 6-12 digital images of your current work, including title, year produced, materials, and dimensions. Images should be in .jpg format and sized at most 1800 pixels on the longest dimension.
