

Fermilab's Artist-in-Residence Program (virtual) – June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022

Fermilab is America's national laboratory dedicated to particle physics research. To initiate and stimulate communication and interactions among scientists, artists and the public, the laboratory has created an artist-in-residence program and seeks applications for the 2021–22 cycle. This call is open to visual artists, composers, choreographers, and writers.

The Fermilab artist-in-residence will interact with scientists at the laboratory, learn about their research, and see how it connects to society. This information will then be used to create a body of work, leading to presentations to the community and possibly an exhibition of the artwork at Fermilab. A small stipend will be provided by Fermi Research Alliance, LLC.

Due to the present circumstances, we are currently planning for virtual residency, including virtual introductions and inspiration.

Applying to the Artist-in-Residence Program

The application period **opens January 1, 2021 and closes March 1, 2021**. Artists might be contacted for a virtual interview and a presentation of examples of their portfolio. The artist must be self-motivating and sufficient.

Artists will be notified by April 15, 2021.

Please submit all of the below (preferred in a single pdf form):

- Resume/CV
- Artist statement
- Letter of intent describing what you hope to accomplish through this virtual residency and how you would contribute to the program and the community
- 1 letter of reference
- 6–12 digital images of your current work, including title, year produced, materials, and dimensions
- Links to webpages and Vimeo are encouraged.
